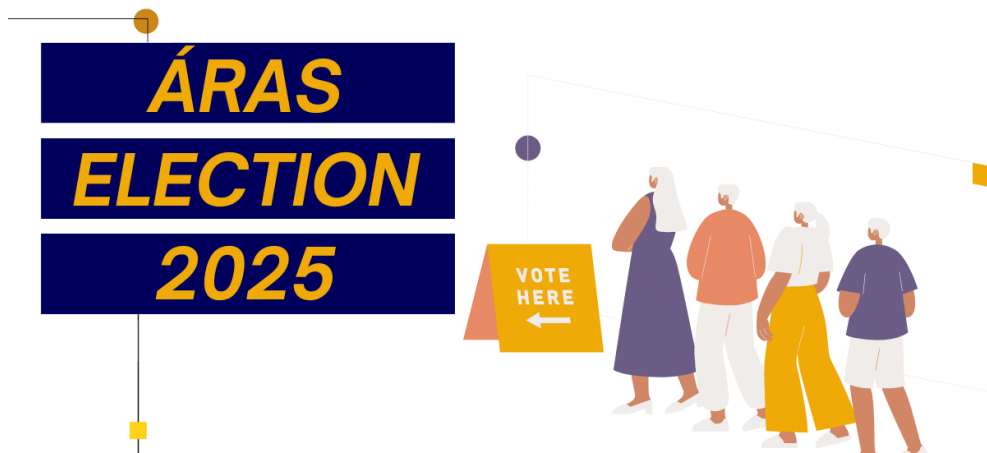


From Free Speech to Violent Rhetoric

Elon Musk's X as a Threat to Electoral Integrity: How Conor McGregor's Irish Presidential Ambitions Unfolded on X

Summary

This report examines how Conor McGregor used X (formerly Twitter) to promote his presidential ambitions in Ireland's 2025 election. Between January and September 2025, EDMO Ireland analysed 127 posts from McGregor's X account related to his campaign. The findings show:

- **High levels of misinformation:** 74 posts (58%) contained false claims about the presidency, the constitution, or Irish history; these include demonstrable false claims about the powers, authority and constitutional limitations of the office of *Uachtarán na hÉireann*. By virtue of McGregor's 10 million followers on X /Twitter, his false claims about Ireland and Irish democracy have reached a wide domestic and international audience.
- **Personal attacks and extremist rhetoric:** McGregor frequently targeted government figures, including Tánaiste Simon Harris, portraying them as traitors and enemies of the Irish people. Ethnonationalist rhetoric appeared in 28% of posts and conspiratorial framing in 14%. Together, these posts depicted the government as a corrupt elite while positioning McGregor as a self-styled defender of Irish culture, democracy, and identity, which he claims is in danger of "extinction".
- **Normalisation of violence:** At least six posts (5%) threatened or implied political violence, including unconstitutional use of state forces and violent threats against public officials. Some posts also targeted migrants and so-called "foreign nationals," amplifying harmful narratives about migrant crime by Irish fringe media figures to a massive global audience.
- **Weak platform moderation:** 23 posts attracted counter-disinformation interventions from the platform's crowd-sourced "Community Notes" fact-checking system. However, none of these proposed notes have been activated, leaving McGregor's misinformation completely unchallenged by the platform.
- **Musk's endorsement and amplification:** Elon Musk publicly endorsed McGregor's candidacy, engaged with his campaign online, stated that he offered financial support, and amplified misinformation about the Irish election. In one post, Musk referred to an Irish political party's legitimate, normal decision to not support independent candidates as "tyrannical" and baselessly claimed the party's leader was "blocking the will of the people".
- **Massive reach:** McGregor's presidential posts were viewed more than 108 million times. International reach extends to his 10.7 million followers, Musk's 226 million followers as well as appearances on outlets such as Tucker Carlson's YouTube channel (4.5 million subscribers) and coverage in global media, including Fox News, Euronews, and USA Today.

The case highlights how weakened moderation on X lets high-profile figures spread misinformation, intolerance, and threats. Although McGregor withdrew his bid hours before seeking formal support from local authorities, the relevance of the case goes beyond his electoral prospects. It reflects Ireland's entry into a global wave of political campaigning that blends celebrity, conspiracy, and authoritarianism while normalising violence and contempt for democracy. It also underscores the political influence and ambitions of the world's richest man and his social media platform.

Background

X and threats to electoral integrity

Electoral integrity refers to the fairness, transparency, and legitimacy of elections. Across the world, it is increasingly threatened by disinformation, foreign interference, declining trust in institutions, and the erosion of norms such as respect for electoral rules, procedures, and outcomes. Digital platforms play a key role in these dynamics because they shape how political actors communicate and how citizens receive information. In recent years, digital platforms have been central to amplifying electoral disinformation and attacks on democratic institutions, including false claims of electoral fraud and related conspiracies.

In response, national and regional regulators have introduced new frameworks. In Ireland, the 2022 Electoral Reform Act established the Electoral Commission with responsibility for protecting the integrity of electoral events by monitoring and addressing disinformation, misinformation, and manipulative behaviour¹. However, this function of the Act (Part 5) has not yet commenced. Within the EU, the Digital Services Act (DSA) introduced new powers to investigate online platforms and to set standards for how online platforms address risks to election integrity. The European Commission is responsible for investigating systemic risks, while national regulators (in Ireland, Coimisiún na Meán) are tasked with ensuring that the required procedures are in place. In the context of elections, national regulators are additionally asked to engage stakeholders, promote media literacy, monitor risks, and respond to incidents and complaints².

Since December 2023, the European Commission has been investigating X over its handling of illegal content and information manipulation. The company has been accused of manipulating the platform's systems to give prominence to far-right posts and politicians³. In addition, X's owner, Elon Musk, has been accused of leveraging his wealth and platform to meddle in the politics of other countries, attacking government politicians while aligning himself with far-right parties and anti-immigrant voices⁴.

Since he acquired X (then Twitter) in 2022, Musk has actively dismantled standards of content moderation, using the rhetoric of free speech and anti-censorship as justification. Research shows, however, that most people support restricting harmful social media content, including physical threats and defamation⁵. Nevertheless, Musk dissolved X's Trust and Safety Council, fired 80% of engineers dedicated to trust and safety⁶, and withdrew X from the EU Code of Practice⁷ on Disinformation. Further changes have given paid-for (premium) accounts greater privileges and visibility, enabling them to profit from the engagement they generate. In addition, Musk promoted 'Community Notes' as an alternative, crowd-sourced model of content moderation. While there is some merit to this

approach when combined with professional moderation, its implementation on X is often inconsistent and lacks transparency⁸.

These factors raise pressing questions about the nature of political speech on X and the potential role of both the platform and its owner in undermining electoral integrity. To address this, EDMO Ireland has examined how Conor McGregor has used X to advance his Irish presidential ambitions and how these posts have been managed by Musk and the Community Notes system.

Conor McGregor and the Irish presidency

In Ireland, the presidency is a largely ceremonial office, though it carries important constitutional functions. The role was set out in the 1937 constitution. The president represents the state, signs bills into law, and may refer legislation to the Supreme Court to test its constitutionality. The president also formally appoints the Taoiseach [prime minister] and government ministers and can dissolve the Dáil [parliament] on the advice of the Taoiseach. While the role has limited executive power, it holds significant symbolic and procedural importance. There are three pathways to appearing on the ballot for the presidential election: nomination by at least 20 members of the Oireachtas (parliament), nomination by at least four local authorities, or self-nomination by a sitting or former president⁹.

In early 2024, Conor McGregor began signalling interest in running for the Irish presidency. Elon Musk commented that it “would be epic” for McGregor to become president and also endorsed McGregor’s call for a no vote in two referendums held in Ireland that year¹⁰. As a high-profile mixed martial arts champion, McGregor is one of Ireland’s most internationally recognisable figures. His public profile, however, has also been marked by controversy: he has faced multiple allegations of sexual abuse and was found liable for sexual assault in a civil case at Ireland’s High Court. In recent years, he has become a prominent figure for the far-right, promoting anti-immigration views to his 46 million Instagram followers and 10 million followers on X¹¹.

In March 2025, US President Donald Trump welcomed McGregor to the White House as a guest of honour on Ireland’s national holiday, where McGregor was also photographed with Elon Musk. Since then, McGregor has continued to present himself as a presidential candidate despite showing little understanding of the role or the nomination process¹². In an April 2025 interview with US talk show host Tucker Carlson, McGregor stated that if he is not on the ballot, “it will become more evident... that we are not a democratic country”¹³. On 4 September, McGregor made a video announcement on X that he was seeking nominations from local authorities to secure a place on the ballot ahead of the 24 September

deadline. That same day, Elon Musk began following McGregor on X. Days later, Musk accused the Tánaiste [deputy prime minister] of “tyrannically blocking the will of the people of Ireland” for allegedly obstructing McGregor’s candidacy. In doing so, Musk amplified misinformation originating from an anonymous X user and a fringe outlet frequently fact-checked for false claims¹⁴. According to the Daily Mail, Musk has held an online meeting with McGregor regarding the presidential campaign the same day¹⁵. On 14 September, McGregor withdrew his bid just hours before he was due to address Dublin City Council and Kildare County Council to ask for their support. Musk later confirmed that he had offered McGregor “offered financial support to get his message out, if needed, but he respectfully declined”.

Against this backdrop, it is important to examine how McGregor’s political messaging has unfolded on X. While it was always unlikely that he would secure a presidential nomination – and polling shows that the vast majority of Irish voters would not have supported him¹⁶ – the significance of this case lies not in McGregor’s political future but in the erosion of democratic norms. It also raises wider questions about the capacity of democratic systems to withstand such challenges.

Method

To analyse McGregor’s use of X to support his presidential campaign, EDMO Ireland compiled a dataset of posts from his account (@TheNotoriousMMA) between 1 January and 4 September 2025. To isolate campaign-related posts from other activity, three steps were taken: (i) initial ethnographic research via NewsWhip and searches on X identified a list of keywords linked to McGregor’s presidential ambitions; (ii) a second search using X’s advanced search function and a Boolean keyword string identified additional relevant posts; and (iii) a third search focused on any post by Conor McGregor within the timeframe that received more than 50,000 likes, ensuring high-engagement posts without pre-identified keywords were also included. Across this period, McGregor posted at least 127 times on X about his presidential ambitions.

Each post was coded using a standard content analysis framework. Typically, election campaign datasets are divided into types of electioneering messages (e.g. policy topics, pleas for support). In this case, our focus was on campaign posts that go beyond routine appeals for support. Each post was therefore categorised into one or more of the following themes: Electioneering; Political Misinformation; Personal Attacks; Intolerance or Hate Speech; Conspiratorial Framing; Ethnonationalist Rhetoric; and Threats of Political Violence. Up to three categories could be applied per post. A full list of posts and their coded categories is provided in the appendix.

Results

The table below presents a breakdown of the thematic focus of McGregor's 127 posts on X. Because each post could be assigned to up to three categories, the total number of thematic codes is higher than the total number of posts.

Thematic focus of McGregor's X posts (n=127)

Electioneering: As the dataset is defined by campaign posts, all 127 posts can be classified as electioneering to some degree. However, almost three-quarters of the posts go beyond electioneering to include elements of misinformation, ethnonationalism, conspiracy, or threats of violence. There were only 33 posts (26%) for which electioneering was the only category applied. For example, a post on 01 August simply stated “vote McGregor” while highlighting a news report about EU fines against Ireland (see Figure 1).

Personal attacks: 10 posts (8%) have been categorised as personal attacks. Some level of personal attack may be expected in a presidential election, as campaigns often target the personal character of individual candidates. In politics generally, it is often legitimate to criticise the past decisions and ethics of political actors. McGregor's attacks, however, are frequently infused with misinformation; for example, when he falsely accused a former president of initiating “Ireland's open border policy” (see Figure 2). In other cases, his personal attacks portray establishment figures as enemies of the Irish people. Notably, McGregor singles out Tánaiste Simon Harris in several posts. In one instance, he describes

the Tánaiste and the former Chief Medical Officer as “treacherous weaklings” while sharing a photograph of Simon Harris receiving a Covid-19 vaccination (see Figure 3). Days later, he highlighted the image again, invoking Harris as the “puny arm of the government trying to stop me from saving our country”. In recent posts, McGregor has described Harris as a “conniving, coward of a man”.

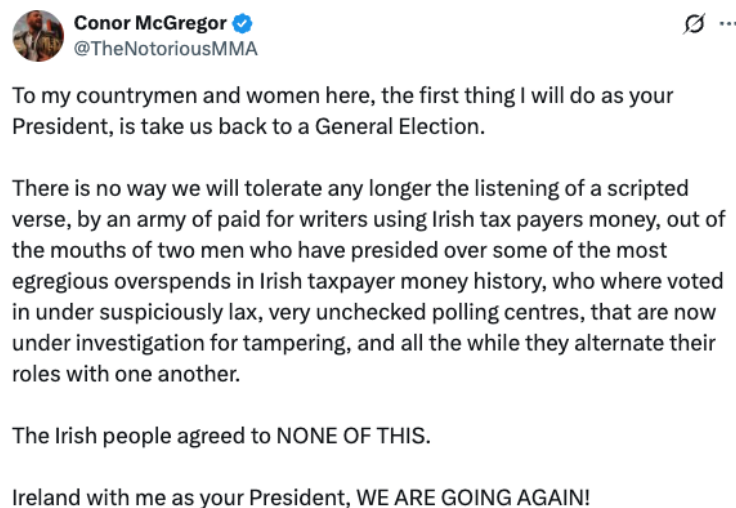


Figure 4: Post falsely claiming the president can call an election, 23 July 2025

Political misinformation: Seventy-four posts (58%) have been categorised as political misinformation for containing some form of demonstrable misinformation or disinformation about politics and the political process. McGregor has frequently misrepresented the powers and role of the Irish president. For example, he has claimed that the president can dissolve the government and call a general election (see Figure 4); unilaterally amend the constitution; summon ministers and order the defunding of NGOs (see Figure 5); and exercise

authority over housing, immigration, trade, and economic policy. He has also advanced claims about Irish history and the constitution that bear no relation to reality.

Ethnonationalist rhetoric: Thirty-six posts (28%) exhibited ethnonationalist rhetoric. These include threats of forced remigration, a promise to close national borders to inward migration, and Islamophobic sentiments. In addition to posts about “the destruction of Ireland” through “population replacement”, McGregor invokes a simple nativism in appeals to “real Irish people”, “Irish-owned businesses” and “real Irish sport” (see Figure 6). He frequently casts himself as “the saviour Ireland needs” and his opponents, “are for the ruination of our land and our culture”. Citing a Gript news story, McGregor directly contrasts himself as an ideal “young, fit, healthy, wealthy, powerful Irish” man with migrants such as “an imported gypsy pimp and his family, on every available welfare package from the hard working Irish tax payer”.

Conspiratorial framing: Eighteen posts (14%) contained some form of conspiratorial framing, in which McGregor presents issues as part of a hidden plot controlled by powerful groups or elites, without evidence. This does not imply that he is explicitly propagating conspiracy theories, but rather that his posts invoke conspiratorial ideas. For example, McGregor claims that the government is deliberately facilitating “the destruction of Ireland” through “the human trafficking scam”, allegedly enabled by the EU Migration Pact. Other posts employ similar frames around COVID-19 vaccines, the legitimacy of the 2024 Irish general election result, and assertions that “the entire Irish mainstream media structure and culture” pose an unspecified “threat” to the nation’s future (see Figure 7).”

Threats of political violence: At least six posts (5%) contained either explicit threats of political violence or implied its use. In three of these, McGregor claimed that, as president, he would deploy state forces in unconstitutional or illegal ways. For example, citing a *Gript* news story about “foreign nationals” assaulting a man, he affirmed that he would be “straight in” to the town with the “army in tow” (see Figure 8). He also promised to round up and deport “criminal ... mentally unstable ... illegal leeches”, suggested that staff at the child and family agency TULSA should be “hung, drawn and quartered”, and threatened to drag the Taoiseach “out of house and home”.

Community Notes: The majority of McGregor’s false claims have no intervention from X moderation. Only 23 posts in the dataset include at least one “proposed community note” via X’s crowdsourced fact-checking system. None have been activated by X, meaning they remain unseen to the majority of X users. X users can sign up to contribute and vote on Community Notes. Once enrolled, they can view “proposed” notes and participate in the

editorial process, which operates in a manner somewhat similar to Wikipedia editing. However, fewer than one million X/Twitter users have registered for Community Notes, meaning that the overwhelming majority of users will never encounter a proposed note¹⁷.

Engagement: Although views alone are a poor indicator of engagement and offer no indication of impact, the total number of views received by McGregor's X posts about the presidency exceeds one hundred million (108,725,310). The dynamics of engagement are striking. McGregor commands an audience of 10.7 million followers on X, dwarfing confirmed presidential candidates such as Catherine Connolly (25.2k) and Heather Humphreys (20.6k). His posts are further amplified when picked up by Elon Musk (225.8 million followers) and when he appears on platforms like Tucker Carlson's YouTube channel (4.52 million subscribers).

McGregor's celebrity status ensures that his presidential ambitions - alongside false claims about the powers of the office and conspiratorial framings of Ireland as a corrupt country falling to migration - receive attention well beyond Ireland. Coverage in Fox News, Euronews, USA Today, Time Magazine, and The Times of India positions his bid within a global news cycle that ordinarily would not feature the Irish presidential at all.

Equally important is the role of fringe, Irish outlets promoting narratives of corrupt elites, demographic replacement, and the need to "save Ireland." While these outlets currently hold little direct sway in the Irish news environment, their claims about Irish politics and electoral processes circulate through McGregor and Musk, which are then amplified via their networks to audiences of millions.

Conclusion

This report indicates how X can be used to distort political debate, amplify harmful rhetoric, and undermine trust in democratic institutions. Under Elon Musk's ownership, X has dismantled trust and safety systems while adopting an interventionist position in some elections. While supporting McGregor's bid in Ireland, Musk also addressed a UK rally led by far-right activist Tommy Robinson. Musk called for a "dissolution of parliament" and "change of government" and told the crowd that "violence is coming" and that "you either fight back or you die"¹⁸.

While Conor McGregor was never likely to secure a presidential nomination, his campaign has wider implications. It highlights how Ireland fits into an international political trend that merges celebrity, online movements, and the vast resources of billionaires to seed and normalise anti-democratic and authoritarian ideas. McGregor has cast Ireland in a transnational story about corruption, elites, and national decline. This story is replicated domestically by fringe media outlets, anonymous social media accounts, and (knowingly or unknowingly) by some mainstream commentators. Internationally, it is endorsed by figures like Elon Musk and Tucker Carlson, which pushes it into mainstream global media.

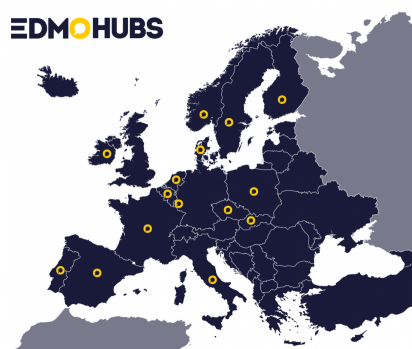

It would be a mistake to dismiss these dynamics. The threats directed at Tánaiste Simon Harris, his family, and their home - alongside reports of heightened security concerns among politicians across the spectrum - show the real-world risks. What is at stake is not simply who wins the 2025 presidential election or who appears on the ballot. It is the normalisation of fact-free and extremist ideas: narratives seeded by fringe media, amplified by celebrities with little political understanding, and broadcast at scale through the platform of the world's richest man.
